I would like to extend a warm welcome to Mrs Fullylove, our new Lunchtime Supervisor in Year One and also to Mrs Jones, our new relief LTS.

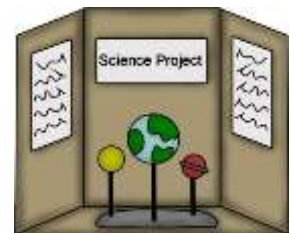
The children were very excited at the arrival of the new playground equipment, that they had chosen through class and school councils (many thanks again to CRISPA for fundraising for this!)
