Staffing


We are pleased to welcome back Mrs Shergold, following her maternity leave. Mrs Shergold is working in Year One at present, but will move to Year Two on 1st April,

Comic Relief


We had some wonderful 'crazy hair' on Red Nose Day! Your £1 donations have so far made £120.
